



**NJ ONE-CALL PROCESS CHANGES SEMINAR**

UTCA has scheduled two workshops to educate our members about the new process for calling in markouts to NJ One Call. **We were successful in delaying the implementation of this requirement until June 30th.** The two changes being made to the way New Jersey One Call processes mark out requests are as follows:

1. The maximum length allowed on any ticket will be a single block for all tickets with or without an address) in an urban/suburban area. If a ticket will extend onto multiple blocks, multiple tickets will be required. The only exception will be if you are working within 500ft of an intersection and will be going in multiple directions from the intersection.
  
2. The maximum length allowed on a ticket in a rural area will be 1500ft. If a ticket will extend beyond 1500ft, multiple tickets will be required.

The BPU indicated that these changes are intended to address the fact that some excavators were not following rules regarding minimum mark-out length. The BPU has also noted that this is standard operating procedure in several other States. NJ One Call Representatives will inform the industry on the updated mark out process and answer questions from the industry.
